A new feature this year is that meals can be obtained in a large marquee on week days only at reasonable charges. Reservations for these by campers and house parties will also be welcomed. ### The Convention Grounds

at Belgrave Heights, 28 miles east of Melbourne, with a beautiful setting of gum trees, bush and ornamental shrubs, has an area of over 20 acres. There are delightful walks through bush tracks and fern gullies to Mt. 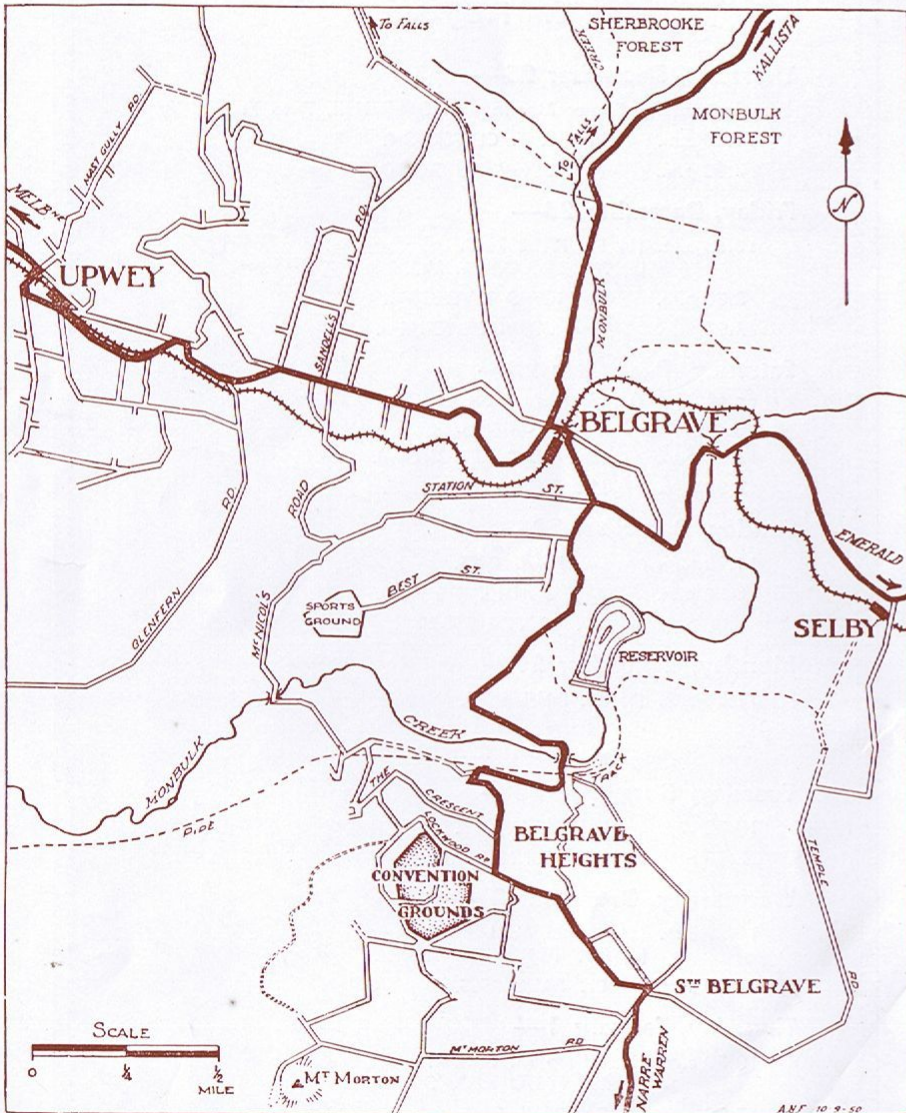


## Travel Directions

**TRAIN** from Flinders Street Station to Ferntree Gully, thence by Bus to Belgrave Heights. Buses leave after all evening meetings.

**MOTORISTS** take main roads to Belgrave, turn right across bridge over railway, and signposts then lead clearly to Belgrave Heights, 2½ miles beyond. An alternative route is to turn right into McNicol Road at Tecoma, and arrow signs lead to Belgrave Heights, two miles ahead.

**SPECIAL BUSES** will also run direct from the city right to the Convention on three main days (Dec. 26 and Jan. 1 and 3). The day return fare is 10/-, and bookings should be made early at the Convention Office, MB 2777.
